Product description

Silirub EPDM is a high-quality, neutral, elastic one-component joint sealant based on fast skinning silicones.

Properties

- Very easy to apply
- Colourfast and UV resistant
- Permanent elastic after curing
- Very good adhesion on many materials
- Low modulus
- Especially developed for EPDM applications.

Applications

 Bonding and sealing of EPDM on EPDM and other building surfaces.

Packaging

Colour: black *Packaging*: 310 ml cartridge

Shelf life

12 months in unopened packaging in a cool and dry storage place at temperatures between +5°C and +25°C.

Substrates

Substrates: all usual building substrates Nature: clean, dry, free of dust and grease. Surface preparation: Porous surfaces in water loaded applications should be primed with Primer 150. No primer needed for non-porous substrates.

There is no adhesion on PE, PP, PTFE (Teflon®) and bituminous substrates. We recommend a preliminary compatibility test. Given the wide variety of EPDM-substrates, we always recommend apreliminary adhesion test.

Joint dimensions

Min. width for bonding: 1 mm *Min. width for joints*: 5 mm *Max. width for joints*: 30 mm *Min. depth for joints*: 5 mm Recommendation sealing jobs: joint width = 2 x joint depth.

Application method

Application method: With manual- or pneumatic caulking gun. Cleaning: Clean with white spirit or Surface Cleaner immediately after use. Finishing: With a soapy solution or Soudal Finishing Solution before skinning. Repair: With the same material

- Do not use on natural stones like marble, granite,...(staining). Use Soudal Silirub MA or Silirub+ S8800 for this application.
- Silirub EPDM is not suitable for applications with permanent water stress (eg horizontal roof sealing joints below the water level).
- Do not use on polycarbonate. Use Silirub PC or Silirub AL instead.
